# **Code of Conduct Revised**

There have been 3 minor changes to the Code of Conduct for Season 2, effective July 1.

- 1. Page 3 now contains an opening paragraph to identify the primary rules under which the BRCCC is incorporated. This does not change anything for members and is purely for your awareness.
- 2. As originally agreed and separately published: Page 21 has been inserted to define the TT-01 Truck class rules.
- 3. Page 20 contains the BRCCC specific Mini class rules. The Motor rule has been changed to allow the shims to be repositioned and to clarify that replacing worn bearings is acceptable. Every other aspect of modifying/tampering remains in force.

#### Log Book

The club now has a formal log book for members to report issues or complaints. This log must not be removed from the control room. The log is an aid to the committee and will ensure you receive an appropriate and timely response to your reports. Each log entry should contain all relevant details, along with names of individuals who can verify or support the matter.
